1st order of draw	Red top tube
2- goes to	Right Atrium
2nd order of draw tube color is	Light blue

A differential count	determines the percentage of each type
A Panel is	A group of tests ordered together
A Plug is	A special paper applied to a wound (small incision) in the forearm. The paper is applied and then tried to see how long it takes for platelets to form a 'plug' and stop the bleeding
ABO (Arterial Blood Gas)	Analyze arterial blood for oxygen, carbon dioxide and bicarbonate content in addition to pH
All blood cells originate from	stem cells in the bone marrow
an embolism is	a clot that moves inside the vessel it is referred to as an embolus
Aortic valve	semi-lunar valve situated between the left ventricle and the aorta
Arterial Blood Gas (ABG)	sample must be run within 15 minutes of collection
Arterial blood is used to	blood gas levels and blood pH. Usually collected by a nurse or respiratory therapist
Aspirin will	determine the absence of microorganisms or by contrast, something that just discourages the growth of microorganisms in a sample
